

TOURNAMENT NAME: Phoenix Rod & Gun NRA Civilian 1500 PPC Tournament

TOURNAMENT DATES: Third Monday of each month.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE: The Phoenix Rod & Gun Club is located at 914 West Olney Drive in Phoenix, Arizona 85041.

1. Take I-10 to Exit 155 for Baseline Road in Phoenix.
2. Go west on Baseline Road for 7.6 miles
3. Turn left (south) onto 7th Avenue for 1.5 miles. 7th Avenue becomes W. Olney Drive.
4. Follow Olney Drive for .1 miles to the entrance gate for Phoenix Rod & Gun Club on the left. There is a second gate at that location for the Phoenix Police Department which has restricted access and must not be used.

RULES: NRA Action Pistol Shooting Rules shall “govern” subject to tournament restrictions provided in this program. The NRA event is pursuant to NRA Action Rule 22 (NRA Civilian PPC Rules).

COMPETITION OPEN TO: Open to all individuals pursuant to NRA rule 1.7 (c) Open Match.

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES: Registration is done and entry fees are paid on the day of and at the tournament location. There is not a separate registration fee. Entry fees are \$10 per individual for the first match entered. If the individual desires to shoot a second gun type in a subsequent relay, at the tournament held on the same day, the fee will be an additional \$5 (see “Tournament Schedule And Conditions” below).

REGISTRATION AND TIME: Registration will start at 8:30 AM and close at 9:00 AM on the day of the tournament. Firing starts at 9:00 AM.

POST ENTRIES: Will not be accepted.

ENTRY LIMIT: Unlimited

CLASSIFICATION OF COMPETITORS: Scores will be submitted to NRA for classification pursuant to NRA Action Rules. **Shooters report scores are accepted for the Police Practical Combat classifications.**

AWARDS: The results of each tournament will be sent out by email and/or US mail to each competitor within 30 days of the tournament date. No awards other than to announce the results will be provided.

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE AND CONDITIONS: This tournament will be held simultaneously with the *law enforcement only* Police Practical Combat tournament held by Phoenix Rod & Gun Club. Official tournament results between the Civilian 1500 PPC and the Law Enforcement PPC tournaments will not be combined.

There will be two types of firearms allowed for the NRA Civilian 1500 PPC. Both types will be scored and shot together. The types allowed are Metallic Sight Firearms per NRA Action Rule 3.2 and Production Firearm per NRA Action Rule 3.2.1. Minimum caliber is 9X19 mm (9mm).

(Note for 2014-2015 just submitted it for Metallic Sight Firearms and not production firearms)

Each match is an “Unsquadded individual match” pursuant to NRA Action Pistol Rule 1.7 (h).

Depending on conditions on the day of the tournament, the match director may allow shooters to enter a second firearm type i.e. shoot their first choice in one relay and a second type in a subsequent relay. That determination will be at the sole discretion of the Match Director as determined on the day of the match.

GENERAL INFORMATION: No eating or housing facilities are available thru the tournament.
