NRA SMALLBORE METRIC PRONE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 12-14 MARCH 2017

Hosted by the Desert Sharpshooters Rifle Club

1. RANGE LOCATION: The Ben Avery Shooting Range, Phoenix, Arizona. The range is on the north side of Phoenix, ½ mile West of I-17 on Carefree Hwy. (Exit 223).
2. FACILITIES: A camping area with full hook-ups is available during the matches for competitors. Anyone desiring a camping site should contact Ben Avery Shooting Range.
3. RULES: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will apply.
4. ELIGIBILITY: The match is open to anyone who wishes to compete.
5. ADVANCED ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED: All entries must be paid in advance.
6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entries on enclosed Registration & Entry form. Entries MUST be accompanied by check, money order or NRA Points and be made payable to the Desert Sharpshooters Rifle Club. Mail to Middleton Tompkins, P.O. Box 11684, Prescott, AZ 86303. Phone: (928) 776-8576. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee, providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00PM, Thursday, 9 March 2017. There will be no refunds for those canceling after that time.
7. ENTRIES CLOSE: 6:00PM, Thursday, 9 March 2017. Entries after this time are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only. An additional \$20.00 will be charged for late entries.
8. ENTRY LIMIT: 160 Individual entries.
9. FEES: All Individual matches.

10. PRACTICE FIRING: The range will be open for practice on Sunday, 12 March from 9:00 to 3:00.
11. TARGETS: NRA A-33 and NRA A-50.
12. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): Approved NRA empty chamber indicators are required to be used at all times except during the preparation period and firing of the relay. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the stat office for \$1.00.
13. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded.

14. CLASSIFICATION: NRA Classifications will be used. All competitors must have a classification. Temporary Classifications are not allowed. Assigned Classifications may be used (Rule 19.6).
15. DIVISION BY RIFLE: There will be two rifle divisions: Sling and F-Class.
16. AWARDS: Monetary awards or trophies or medals will be given. Awards will be given to match winners, regardless of category, and individuals in each category/class award group. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each seven (7) competitors. Example: Second 8-14, Third 15-21, etc.
17. NRA will provide Championship Medallions for Grand Aggregate Winner, 2nd and 3rd place.
18. SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In the Grand Aggregate an award will be given to the High Junior and Senior if there are 5 or more entries. Awards will be given in F-Class if there are 5 or more entries. F-Class will not be recognized for the National Championship and will receive separate awards.
19. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends at 9:00AM on day two for day one scores and ½ hour after the posting of the last match results on day two.
20. RESULTS BULLETINS: The results bulletin will be posted on the Desert Sharpshooters website.

There will be open practice from 9:00AM until 3:00PM.

Monday, 13 March 2017

MATCH 1: 20 shots at 50 meters and 20 shots at 100 meters. Iron Sights.

MATCH 2: 40 Shots at 100 meters fired in two 20 shots strings. Iron Sights.

MATCH 3: 40 shots at 50 meters fired in two 20 shots strings. Iron Sights.

MATCH 4: Iron sight aggregate Matches 1-3.

Tuesday, 14 March 2017

MATCH 5: 20 shots at 50 meters and 20 shots at 100 meters. Any Sights.

MATCH 6: 40 shots at 100 meters fired in two 20 shots strings. Any Sights.

MATCH 7: 40 shots at 50 meters fired in two 20 shots strings. Any Sights.

MATCH 8: Any sight aggregate Matches 5-7.

MATCH 9. NRA METRIC NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP; combined Matches of 4 and 8.
