Title: **Carry Policy**

PRGC enthusiastically supports the right of Americans to safely carry guns.

The grounds of PRGC are located within the borders of the State of Arizona. Any person who is legally permitted to carry a gun in Arizona may carry openly or concealed at PRGC.

The following protocols apply in order to ensure safety in a gun-friendly environment:

- Carry guns must remain holstered at all times. (exceptions below).
 - If you wish to remove your carry gun to unload it and set it on the shooting bench for shooting, display or other reason, do so at a HOT range (advise the RO) or other location where it can be safely handled and an AD (accidental discharge) presents no risk (such as a sand barrel).
 - Drawing from a holster to shoot will be conducted in accordance to the rules of the competition or RO when present.
 - Removal and holstering of carry guns should be conducted in a safe manner that ensures no one is “swept” and the 180 degree rule is not broken. (This might limit the choices of holster style usable for carry at PRGC).
- Where required by NGB (National Governing Body) rules, a PRGC competition division may enact a “cold range” policy for participants in NGB approved/registered competitions.
