Rules: Current NRA / CMP Rules will govern.

Entries: Limited to 40 competitors. Pre-Registration is expected, but you can sign up and pay at the range if there is space available.

Categories / Classes: The NRA Classification system will be used. Separate class awards will be given in each of two Categories: Civilian and Service. Members of the active Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Air Force, National Guard, Reserve and Police will make up the Service Category. All others will be considered Civilians.

- 1. If there are less than five entries in any category within a class, they will be combined with other entries in another category within the same class.
- 2. If there are less than five entries after combining all categories of a class, there will be NO AWARDS provided in that class and all competitors in the lower class will be moved to their respective category in the next higher class.
- If the five-competitor minimum required for award purposes has still not been fulfilled, competitors will be moved up in class and category until there are five or more in a class and category.
- 4. A class or category will not be combined downward. If there are less than five High Masters, they will compete for Match Winner only.

Awards:

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP, MATCH #16

WINNER Named Arizona State Champion and awarded \$25.00. Name engraved on permanent trophy. Must be an Arizona State resident to win "State Champion" Title.

Cash awards will be issued to shooters for matches and aggregate matches by class and category for the 2700.

A Souvenir award will be issued to each competitor.

Special category awards of \$10.00 each will be provided to the high Woman, Junior, Senior, and Grand Senior.

Match No. 5 .22 Caliber, an aggregate of Matches 1, 2, 3, and 4 Match No. 10 Center Fire, an aggregate of Matches 6, 7, 8, and 9 Match No. 15 .45 Caliber, an aggregate of Matches 11, 12, 13, and 14 Match No. 16 Aggregate of Matches 5, 10, and 15

Other Information

- 1. **Weather:** The pistol range firing points are covered, and the match will be conducted rain or shine.
- 2. **Camping** is available and free on-site, but only limited electrical hook-ups are available. Approval to camp is required.
- 3. Lunch will be available for a donation.
- 4. **TEAMS:** will consist of two or four members, one alternate, a captain and/or coach, and will represent either a club affiliated with NRA, a law enforcement agency, a regular service or reserve unit (including the National Guard). State Association Teams may enter the team matches. Five teams are needed to establish a Class, no categories.

Service Pistol and .22 Excellence in Competition Matches CMP Sanctioned Matches

The CMP Service Pistol EIC Match and .22 Rimfire EIC Match are sponsored by the Phoenix Rod and Gun Club, Pistol Division.

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate.

Time, Date & Match Fees:

Matches will be held on Saturday and Sunday, October 9 and 10, 2021.

Fees are \$18 per match and \$10 per match for Collegiate / Juniors.

Course of Fire: For Service Pistol EIC and CMP .22 Rim Fire EIC - the 30 shot National Match Course of Fire, 50/25 yds.

Firearm: "Service Pistol," ".22 Rimfire Pistol" as defined in the Current Edition of the CMP rules.

Entries: List the number of entries accepted or make note, there must be at least six non-distinguished shooters. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

Awards: Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors (Distinguished and Non-Distinguished) in CMP-Sanctioned EIC Matches that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores. **Points** – Points are given to any non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score. All Points are issued by the CMP.

Minimum EIC Scores – To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.2.6 (top 10%) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline. MCS scores are:

- Service Pistol. 250 of 300
- .22 Rimfire Pistol. 260 of 300

Rules: All EIC matches will be conducted in accordance with the current edition of the CMP Pistol Competition Rules.
