**Categories / Classes:** The NRA Classification system will be used. Separate class awards will be given in each of two Categories: Civilian and Service. Members of the active Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Air Force, National Guard, Reserve and Police will make up the Service Category. All others will be considered Civilians.

1. If there are less than five entries in any category within a class, they will be combined with other entries in another category within the same class.
2. If there are less than five entries after combining all categories of a class, there will be NO AWARDS provided in that class and all competitors in the lower class will be moved to their respective category in the next higher class.
3. If the five-competitor minimum required for award purposes has still not been fulfilled, competitors will be moved up in class and category until there are five or more in a class and category.
4. A class or category will not be combined downward. If there are less than five High Masters, they will compete for Match Winner only.

Match No. 11 – 20 shots, slow fire, 50 yards

**Other Information**

1. **Weather:** The pistol range firing points are covered, and the match will be conducted rain or shine.
2. **Camping** is available and free on-site, but only limited electrical hook-ups are available. Approval to camp is required.
3. **Lunch** will be available for a donation.
4. **TEAMS:** will consist of two or four firing members, one alternate, a captain and/or coach, and will represent either a club affiliated with NRA, a law enforcement agency, a regular service or reserve unit (including the National Guard). The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team. State Association Teams may enter the team matches. Five teams are needed to establish a Class, no categories.

## **Service Pistol and .22 Excellence in Competition Matches CMP Sanctioned Matches**

**The CMP Service Pistol EIC Match and .22 Rimfire EIC Match are sponsored by the Phoenix Rod and Gun Club, Pistol Division**

**Eligibility:** Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate.

### **Time, Date & Match Fees:**

Matches will be held on Saturday and Sunday, April 23 and 24, 2022.

Fees are \$18 per match for adults and \$10 per match for Collegiate / Juniors.

**Course of Fire:** For Service Pistol EIC and CMP .22 Rim Fire EIC Pistol - the 30 shot National Match Course of Fire, 50/25 yds.

**Firearm:** "Service Pistol," ".22 Rimfire Pistol" as defined in the Current Edition of the CMP rules.

**Entries:** There must be at least six non-distinguished shooters for Points to be awarded. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

**Awards:** Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished) that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores.

**Points** – Points are given to non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score. All Points are issued by the CMP.

**Minimum EIC Scores** – To receive EIC credit Points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.2.6 (top 10%) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline. MCS scores are:

- Service Pistol. 250 of 300
- .22 Rimfire Pistol. 260 of 300

**Rules:** All EIC matches will be conducted in accordance with the current edition of the CMP Pistol Competition Rules.
