EIC MATCH PROGRAM:

CMP Service Pistol, 22 Rimfire Pistol, EIC CMP Revolver

The CMP Service Pistol EIC Match, 22 Rimfire EIC and EIC CMP Revolver Matches are sponsored by: White Mountain Shooters Association

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or

a CMP affiliated club to participate

Course of Fire: For Service Pistol EIC and CMP.22 Rim Fire EIC is the 30 shot National

Match Course of Fire and the EIC CMP Revolver is 40 shots P100 Format.

Firearm: "Service Pistol,"+".22 Rimfire Pistol"+ "CMP Revolver as defined in the

Current Edition of the CMP Service Rulebook.

Entries: List the number of entries accepted or make note, there must be at least six

non-distinguished shooters. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

Awards: Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors

(Distinguished or Non-Distinguished), that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores. <u>Points</u> – Points are given to any non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score (Rule, 9.2.7). Calculations are based on rule 9.2.6.

All Points are issued by the CMP.

Minimum Scores To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must

fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.2.6 (top 10%) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline (see CMP Rule 9.2.7).

MCS scores for 2019 are:

Service Pistol. 250 of 300

.22 Rimfire Pistol, 260 of 300

• Service Revolver. 315 of 400


Rules: In accordance with the current edition of the CMP Service Rulebook. All
