NRA Approved International Pistol Matches And CMP AP-EIC Matches

Eligibility: NRA membership is not required. NRA and CMP numbers are required if you want your scores tracked by them.

Rules: Current NRA International and CMP Rules will govern.

Entries: Limited to 20 competitors for Air Pistol and to 40 competitors for other disciplines. Pre-Registration is expected, but you can sign up and pay at the range if there is space available.

Classifications: The NRA Classification system will be used. Classifications will be established only if there are 5 or more competitors in a class. Competitors may be combined with competitors of a higher classification to form a class. No other classified competitor will be combined with the Master class.

Awards: Cash in each discipline to the top shooters as determined by the number of shooters in each discipline.

Courses of Fire:

Free Pistol: Fired at 50 yards on 50 meter reduced (B-19) targets. Time 2 hours includes sighters.

Standard Pistol: Fired at 25 yards on 25 meter reduced (B-19) targets. Four 5 -shot series. Slow Fire 2 ½ minutes per series; Four 5 - shot series, 20 seconds per series; Four 5 - shot Series in 10 seconds each.

Center Fire / Sport Pistol: Fired at 25 yards on 25 meter reduced (B-19) targets and (B-38) targets. 30 shots slow fire on B19 target and 30 shots Rapid Fire on (B-38) target. Precision Fire; 5 shots in 5 minutes, Rapid Fire sequence is 7 seconds edged, 3 seconds faced. Center Fire is shot with any CF pistol, from .32 to .38 or 9mm. Sport Pistol is fired with .22 pistols and is open only to women and male juniors / collegiates.

Air Pistol: Fired indoors at 10 meters on electronic targets. Unlimited sighters and 60 shots for record. Time limit 1 hour and forty-five minutes, including sighters. Five firing points are available for each relay.

Other Information

1. **Weather:** The pistol range firing points are covered, and the match will be conducted rain or shine.
2. **Camping** is available and free on-site, but only limited electrical hook-ups are available. Approval to camp is required.
3. **Contact and Registration Information:**
Shooters will fill out the attached SR-1 Card and send it in accompanied by check or money order, payable to Phoenix Rod and Gun Club. Circle the number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your NRA classifications. You may pay at the range as long as you have contacted me to reserve a place on the line. The PRGC waivers will be signed at site registration.

Air Pistol Excellence in Competition Matches CMP Sanctioned Matches

The CMP Air Pistol EIC Matches are sponsored by the Phoenix Rod and Gun Club, Pistol Division.

Eligibility: You need not be a member of a CMP affiliated club to participate but must have a CMP number if you want your scores tracked. Limited to 20 competitors.

Time, Date & Match Fees:

Matches will be held as shown on Page 1 of this bulletin.

Fees are \$15 for adults and \$8 for Collegiates / Juniors.

Course of Fire: Air Pistol EIC – Fired at 10 meters on electronic targets. Preparation and unlimited sighters for 15 minutes and 60 shots for record fired in one hour and fifteen minutes.

Firearm: “Air Pistol” as defined in the current edition of the CMP rules.

Entries: There must be at least six non-distinguished shooters for EIC credit points to be awarded. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

Awards: Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished) that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores.

Points – Points are given to non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score. All points are issued by the CMP.

Minimum Credit EIC Score – To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 11.3.5 and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) of 540 x 600.

Rules: All EIC matches will be conducted in accordance with the current CMP AIR RIFLE AND AIR PISTOL COMPETITION RULES.
