

Phoenix Rod and Gun Club
2025 NRA INTERNATIONAL SECTIONAL PISTOL MATCH PROGRAM

The 2025 NRA Registered International Sectional International Tournament will be held at the indoor range of the Phoenix Rod & Gun Club on March 15 and 16, 2025.

Location: Phoenix Rod & Gun Club, 915 W. Olney, Phoenix, AZ. South end of 7th Avenue. The indoor range is in the main office building, side entrance.

Match Dates:

Saturday March 15, 2025 8:30 AM Relay 1
1:00 PM Relay 2

Sunday March 16, 2025 8:30 AM Relay 3
1:00 PM Relay 4

Each relay will consist of Air Pistol, Free Pistol, and Standard Pistol matches. AP firing will be done with pistols that meet CMP requirements. Free and Standard Pistol firing will be done with .22 LR pistols that meet NRA requirements.

Eligibility: NRA membership is not required.

Rules: Current NRA International Rules will govern.

Entries: Will be limited to 20 competitors, five in each relay.

Categories / Classes:

Current International shooting classification system will be used. Categories will be established if there are 5 or more competitors per category.

Less than 5 competitors will be combined with competitors of a higher classification to form a class. No other classified competitor will be combined with the Master class.

Awards:

Medals will be provided by NRA for the first, second, and third place winners of each match.

Cash awards will be provided to the Winner and other shooters for each match.

Courses of Fire:

All firing will be done in the indoor range at 50 ft except for Air Pistol, which will be fired at 10 meters.

Air Pistol: See Page 3

Free Pistol: 60 shots fired at 50 feet on the B11Target, 15 Minutes for Prep and sighters.
1 Hour 30 minutes for record firing.

Standard Pistol: All fired on the B33 target.

SLOW -- 20 shots fired in 4 – 5 shot strings, 2 ½ minutes per string.

TIMED -- 20 shots fired in 4 – 5 shot strings, 20 seconds per string.

RAPID -- 20 shots fired in 4 – 5 shot strings, 10 seconds per string.

Team Matches:

Team matches will be paper matches using the team member's individual scores.

Scoring:

Scoring will be done after each match is complete.

Other Information:

1. On-site registration is acceptable if there is space available.
2. Camping is available and free on-site, but approval is required, and limited electrical hook-ups are available.

Air Pistol Excellence in Competition Matches

CMP Sanctioned Matches

The CMP Air Pistol EIC Matches are sponsored by the Phoenix Rod and Gun Club, Pistol Division.

Eligibility: You must have a CMP number if you want your scores tracked. Limited to 20 competitors.

Time, Date & Match Fees:

Matches will be held as shown on Page 1.

Fees are \$15 for adults and \$8 for Collegiates / Juniors.

Course of Fire: 60 shots at 10 meters. Preparation and Sighting stage – 15 minutes and Record Fire time of 90 minutes. Electronic targets will be used.

Firearm: “Air Pistol” as defined in the current edition of the CMP rules.

Entries: There must be at least six non-distinguished shooters for EIC credit points to be awarded. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

Awards: Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished) that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores.

Points – Points are given to non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score. All points are issued by the CMP.

Minimum Credit EIC Score – To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 11.3.5 and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) of 540 x 600.

Rules: The AP EIC match will be conducted in accordance with the current CMP rules.
