

# 2026 Precision Pistol Indoor Sectional NRA Registered Match

**Location:** Phoenix Rod & Gun Club, 915 W. Olney, Phoenix, AZ. South end of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The indoor range is entered from the left-side door of the office building just beyond the outdoor pistol range.

A team match will be fired at the conclusion of each relay. The entire team need not shoot on the same relay. Bring 90 + 30 rounds.

**Eligibility:** NRA membership is not required. Individual and Team Entries close prior to individual's shooting.

**Rules:** Current NRA Rules will govern.

**Entries:** Nominally limited to 40 competitors.

**Categories / Classes:** The NRA Classification system will be used. Separate class awards will be given in each of two Categories: Civilian and Service. Members of the active Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Air Force, National Guard, Reserve and Police will make up the Service Category. All others will be considered Civilians.

1. If there are less than five entries in any category within a class, they will be combined with other entries in another category within the same class.

2. If there are less than five entries after combining all categories of a class, there will be NO AWARDS provided in that class and all competitors in the lower class will be moved to their respective category in the next higher class.
3. If the five-competitor minimum required for award purposes has still not been fulfilled, competitors will be moved up in class and category until there are five or more in a class and category.
4. A class or category will not be combined downward. If there are less than five High Masters, they will compete for Match Winner only.

### **Awards:**

Winner - Gold Medallion  
Second – Silver Medallion  
Third – Bronze Medallion

Overall and Winning Team – NRA provided awards

Each shooter will receive a Souvenir pin provided by the NRA.

Cash awards will be issued to shooters for matches and aggregate matches by class and by category.

**Course of Fire:** .22 LR caliber pistols meeting NRA rules must be used. Shooting is at 50 ft on turning targets. B-2 targets will be used for slow fire and B-3 targets used for sustained fire. Note that PRGC has only 5 firing points.

Match No. 1 – 20 shots, slow fire  
Match No. 2 – 30 shots National Match Course  
Match No. 3 – 20 shots, timed fire  
Match No. 4 – 20 shots, rapid fire  
Match No. 5 - Aggregate of Matches 1, 2, 3, and 4  
Match No. 6 – Team Match – fired National Match Course

Teams will consist of four firing members representing an NRA affiliated club, state association, law enforcement agency, a regular service, National Guard or Reserve Unit.

### **Other Information**

1. **Camping** is available and free on-site, but limited electrical hook-ups are available.
