Eligibility: NRA membership is not required.

Rules: Current NRA International and CMP Rules will govern.

Entries: Limited to 40 competitors. Pre-Registration is expected, but you can sign up and pay at the range if there is space available.

Classifications: The NRA Classification system will be used. Classifications will be established only if there are 3 or more competitors in a class. Competitors may be combined with competitors of a higher classification to form a class. No other classified competitor will be combined with the Master class.

Awards: Cash in each discipline to the top shooters as determined by the number of shooters in each discipline.

A Souvenir award will be issued to each competitor.

Course of Fire:

Free Pistol: Fired at 50 yards on reduced (B-19) targets. Time 2 hours which includes sighters.

Standard Pistol: Fired at 25 yards on 25 meters reduced (B-19) targets. Four 5 - shot series of Slow Fire 2 ½ minutes per series; Four 5 - shot series of Timed Fire, 20 seconds per series; Four 5 - shot Series of Rapid Fire, 10 seconds per series.

Center Fire Pistol and Sport Pistol: Fired at 25 yards on 25 meter reduced (B-19) targets and (B-38) targets. 30 shots slow fire on B19 targets and 30 shots Rapid Fire on (B-38) targets. Precision Fire; 5 shots in 5 minutes, Rapid Fire sequence is 7 seconds edged, 3 seconds faced.

Sport Pistol is fired with .22 pistols and is open only to women and male juniors / collegiates.

Air Pistol: Provided on page 3.

Other Information

1. **Weather:** The pistol range firing points are covered, and the match will be conducted rain or shine.
2. **Camping** is available and free on-site, but only limited electrical hook-ups are available. Approval to camp is required.
3. **Lunch** will be available for a donation.

Air Pistol Excellence in Competition Matches CMP Sanctioned Matches

The CMP Air Pistol EIC Matches are sponsored by the Phoenix Rod and Gun Club, Pistol Division.

Eligibility: You must have a CMP number if you want your scores tracked.

Time, Date & Match Fees:

Matches will be held as shown on Page 1.

Fees are \$20 for adults and \$10 for Collegiates / Juniors.

Course of Fire: 60 shots at 10 meters. Preparation and Sighting stage – 15 minutes and Record Fire time of 90 minutes. Electronic targets will be used.

Firearm: “Air Pistol” as defined in the current edition of the CMP rules.

Entries: There must be at least six non-distinguished shooters for EIC credit points to be awarded. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

Awards: Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished) that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores.

Points – Points are given to non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score. All points are issued by the CMP.

Minimum Credit EIC Score – To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 11.3.5 and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) of 540 x 600.

Rules: The AP EIC match will be conducted in accordance with the current CMP rules.
