

# Phoenix Rod & Gun Club Policy (PRGC)

## Camping Policy

Adopted by BOD 03/11/2020

1. Camping at the PRGC range is permitted at no charge as part of competing in shooting matches. Priority goes to competitors in formal shooting events on a first-to-request approval basis.
2. Camping must be approved by the Facilities Manager (FM) or Board of Directors (BoD). PRGC members need no pre-approval for single-night camping prior to a scheduled shooting event.
3. Campers may stay up to 15 consecutive days.
4. At least one person must occupy a camping area during the first night and after camping equipment has been setup. Camping equipment cannot be left unattended for more than 24 hours.
5. PRGC will assign an event gate code that can be given to campers to allow after-hours access.
6. A standard "Permit" sign will be issued by the FM to place on the camper/RV indicating approval.
7. The FM shall identify safe and non-intrusive parking locations for camper/RV placement.
8. Camping permission may be withheld or withdrawn at any time by the FM or BoD if the camper:
  - a. Represents a threat to safety or the security of the Club or to our lease-defined mission as a marksmanship organization.
  - b. Has been determined to not be using the facility for the designated marksmanship purpose.
  - c. Is in violation of any of the PRGC By-Laws and Policies.
9. Any member found to be in violation of this or other PRGC policy shall be subject to disciplinary action from the BOD up to and including revocation of membership.
