

# Phoenix Rod & Gun Club

## Guest Policy

Adopted July 08, 2020

1. To bring guests is a privilege of membership at PRGC. PRGC members are welcome and encouraged to bring guests to the Club to introduce new shooters to the shooting sports and to the Club.
2. There will be no “guest fee” for guests supervised by their PRGC member hosts in a member’s only setting.
3. Since PRGC incurs an expense to operate the Public Range, non-members at the Public Range during public hours will be considered public shooters rather than guest and pay the public fee. Non-members shooting a formal per fee event (such as a match) will pay the appropriate non-member fee for that event.
4. The PRGC member host is the supervisor of his guests and safety officer over their shooting during their visit. Using the Range Sign-In Sheet, Waiver and Release of Liability Form located on each range, both member and guests shall sign-in and sign-out when using any range other than during scheduled shooting events. If guest is a minor, the minor’s and responsible adult’s name shall be logged and the responsible adult shall sign for the minor. Failure to follow this policy will subject the member to disciplinary measures at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
5. Unless more guests are authorized by the Facilities Manager or a Division Director, members may only bring up to 2 guest and/or their immediate family (immediate family is defined as the member and his/her spouse). PRGC members are expected to use judgment and only allow that number of guests to shoot or handle firearms as he/she can safely supervise and that do not interfere with other members or safe club operations.
6. PRGC members may not abuse this privilege by neglecting to supervise their guests or charging and pocketing a private range fee or operating for-fee training/shooting, or multiple adults sharing the costs of one “membership” to avoid each adult having to purchase a full membership, or other manners of abuse.
7. Where the conduct of a guest or his/her PRGC member host creates a safety risk or unnecessarily degrades the shooting experience of others at PRGC, that guest privilege may be rescinded.
8. At the Division Director’s discretion, he/she may offer complementary match entries to individuals for services rendered to the division.
