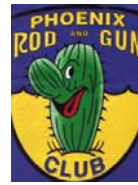

Title: **High Performance Ammunition**

- High Performance ammunition:
 - Any ammunition with greater than 10,000 ft-lbs muzzle energy.
 - Any ammunition firing a non-expanding solid bullet over 250 gr with a muzzle velocity over 2600fps.
- Special limitations on High Performance ammunition:
 - High Performance ammunition requires approval by a range officer, shoot director or board member and may be fired on the public range or the high power range only, with impacts in the soft-dirt impact berms only. Approval can be given to those shooters known to be proficient enough to ensure such an impact or to those who provide a physical mechanism (such as a barricade with a firing port) to limit the direction the muzzle can be pointed to the soft-dirt impact berms.
- This policy does not include .50 BMG which is covered by a separate rule.
