## Phoenix Rod and Gun Club High Power Range Usage

## The following rules must observed at all times:

- The High Power range is for use only by PRGC Club members and their guests, unless participating in a club sanctioned match.
- Members must display a current PRGC membership badge at all times.
- All users must sign into each range.
- During a ceasefire, firearms must be unloaded, magazines out, safety on, actions open.
- Authorized distances: 100, 200, 300 & 500yards.
- Target Placement: Pit target carrier area west of steel gongs and 100 yard berm.
- **No .50 BMGs, automatic firearms or personal metal targets**. Frames must be returned and not left downrange or in the target carriers.
- All shooters that use the 200/300/500 yard ranges are expected to have a suitable firearm that is properly sighted in to shoot those distances.
- All shots must impact the target and/or back stop.
- Be courteous and respectful to other shooters and share the range.

## **Long Range procedure**:

- The 300 & 500 yard lines are restricted and can only be used during authorized Long Range times.
- Ensure the entire High Power range and pistol bays on the High Power range area is safe and clear of any individuals and vehicles.
- Then secure the 300 yard line main gate closed before setting up and shooting at either the 300 or the 500 lines
- It is a first come first serve basis for selecting the long range distances during the club practice times.
- When the gate is closed, no one will open or otherwise pass through the gate, without coordinating a cease-fire with the person who closed it and other HP users.
- The closed gate controls access and signifies to everyone that there is an active user at 300 or 500 yards. After long range usage is complete, open the 300yard gate before leaving the club.
